## 1. Economic Recovery and Growth

Given the current climate of federal and global fiscal restraint, what specific federal measures do you feel are needed for a sustained economic recovery and enhanced economic growth in Canada?

- an increased use of environmentally friendly sources of power. - a decrease in the export of natural resources in favour of doing the processing and manufacturing in Canada. - both of these initiatives would increase employment - less dependence on U.S. markets

- we should make it easier for skilled people to immigrate into Canada - we should be training more health care workers and should be making jobs in this sector stable and financially attractive. - there should be more supports in place to keep seniors in their own homes.

With labour market challenges arising in part as a result of the aging of Canada's population and an ongoing focus on the actions needed for competitiveness, what specific federal initiatives are needed in order to increase productivity in Canada?

- job creation should focus on full time stable employment

#### 5. Other Challenges

With some Canadian individuals, businesses and communities facing particular challenges at this time, in your view, who is facing the most challenges, what are the challenges that are being faced and what specific federal actions are needed to address these challenges?

I feel that seniors and health workers are facing the greatest challenges. The Canada Pension Plan and Old Age Security payments should be increased. There should be no private health care in this country. Funding for the CBC should be increased. It is a major influence in what makes us Canadian and is a national treasure.
