## 1. Economic Recovery and Growth

Given the current climate of federal and global fiscal restraint, what specific federal measures do you feel are needed for a sustained economic recovery and enhanced economic growth in Canada?

1. Education and research. Financing research in all academic fields, economics to pure mathematics. Promoting quality education in grade K-12. 2. Promotion of arts and culture. A promotion of trades, introducing such programs in high school (which is already done to an extent, but could be much improved). Education in university is not the correct venue for most. Most graduate with a bachelor's in anything, achieving a C average and never having had the opportunity to really engage. Trades need to be discussed as an equally beneficial and challenging opportunity, perhaps even more in cases. Programs such as LinkAges in Alberta, and other generation-bridging programs across canada need to be encouraged, funded, and supported. Younger generations volunteering with the aging population is also necessary. Look into LinAges, they are solving problems you want to solve.

## 4. Productivity

With labour market challenges arising in part as a result of the aging of Canada's population and an ongoing focus on the actions needed for competitiveness, what specific federal initiatives are needed in order to increase productivity in Canada?
