

Dear Standing Committee on Justice and Human Rights,

I am writing to ask you to amend the Bill C-14 to consider the following:

- Respect and protect the conscience of all institutions, hospitals and health care workers including physicians and pharmacists who do not want to participate in the assisted suicide or who do not want to refer patients to physicians who participate in it.
- Provide safeguards for health care workers in order that they are not discriminated or penalized for refusing to participate or refusing to refer patients.
- Do not allow individuals under 18 to request for the physician-assisted suicide.
- Do not allow parents, guardians, or caregivers to request or approve the assisted suicide on behalf of their children, care-receivers, mentally incompetent, or disabled people.
- Add more thorough restrictions and safeguards for the Section 4. Currently there is no restrictions for \*anyone over 18\* to sign a request for the physician-assisted suicide.

Thank you for considering and accepting this submission on Bill C-14.
