We would like to see the complete prohibition of assisted suicide.

If this is not possible, we would like to see:

- that C-14 does not allow assisted suicide for those with mental illness, mental and or physical disability and for mature minors.
- that doctors and health professionals will be protected by the chartered rights, stating that they will not be forced to participate in any way.
- that palliative care be made accessible to all and this becomes mandatory in law.
- that there be a third party review, ensured before all proposed deaths.
- that only those with terminal illness be considered and that the term, reasonably foreseeable be properly defined.
- that only doctors will be permitted to assist.
