Hybrid voting: technical background briefing

Ottawa, Ontario – February 25, 2021

Further to the [motion](#) extending hybrid proceedings, the Honourable Anthony Rota, Speaker of the House of Commons, has received notice from the House Leaders of all recognized parties that they are satisfied that the electronic voting system is ready to be used by Members who are participating remotely in hybrid proceedings. All Members have been advised.

As of February 26 and until June 23, 2021, Members voting remotely will use the new electronic voting system. Members voting in the Chamber will continue to vote in the traditional manner.

A technical background briefing on the new hybrid voting process will be offered by the House of Commons on **Monday, March 8, 2021, at 9:00 a.m.**

Stéphan Aubé, Chief Information Officer, and Ian McDonald, Senior Principal Clerk, Parliamentary Information and Publications, will provide an overview of the electronic voting system adopted by the House in support of hybrid proceedings.
