On an issue of this importance, I decided to give everyone in the riding of Langley-Aldergrove an opportunity to have their voice heard. That could only be accomplished if the enclosed information booklet and survey were sent to every household in the riding of Langley-Aldergrove. The results are in and the response was enormous.

When asked if the Government should hold a national referendum in order to hear directly from Canadians before changing our voting system, my constituents overwhelmingly (90%) demanded that a referendum be held.
