I would like to mention my deep concern with the government's decision to pass Bill C-205 without any publication on the news, or anywhere else for that matter. I was disappointed to find out through a friend that this bill is already in second reading and that tomorrow on Friday, June 4<sup>th</sup>, is already the deadline to submit any briefs or oppose this Bill in any way, not giving us much opportunity to debate or reflect the thoughts of the public.
