Been here for 15, years, I have seen the world of sexual exploitation, change in front of me of but the changes are not keeping up with the crimes, of abuse that we are facing every day, thru sexual exploitation. Especially if it a love control of a boyfriend, power of his fists, keeps her or him there. Everyday our office gets a call from families asking for help, to understand how they can support their loved ones, of sexual exploitation. We get daily calls for victims wanting out, the problem is the "exit" procedure needs to have more supports put in place, to support our people, such as trauma counselling. Support of other peers of lived experiences, I run a sharing circle every Monday for peers of lived experiences of exploitation, it helps. Education of sexual exploitation needs to be taught at every nation. As young as we can, when our youth are forced to sell themselves for basic needs, to survive, we are not breaking the cycle, with no education. Familia exploitation within the nations is the biggest crime, if grandpa or elder or uncle exploit our youth, going to court & charging them will be hard, if they live next door, our nations need to make laws of keeping predators off the nations. To have safety procedures put in place for the victim to testify their family perpetrators. I think we need to have Peers of sexual exploitation on every nation to teach our youth, Breaking the chain of sexual exploitation, starts at home, lets educate the parents, we can use a massive campaign for our indigenous families to learn and speak up, until we honestly stand up give them the right language and education., to speak and share, we are able to combat it sexual exploitation, by having an honest conversation. I know this is everywhere, but I know and see what I am talking about, I am survivor of lived experience to 25 years, I was able to get help, to find my voice, sharing is caring.
