To the Standing Committee on Justice and Human Rights,

I am writing to you in regards to the Justice Committee's Bill C-6 deliberation on Conversion Therapy. I am concerned that the definition used in the applicable legislation is vague and in need of clarification. I would respectfully advocate that you, the Standing Committee on Justice and Human Rights, and your party adopt the following amendments to Bill C-6:

- 1) Ensure that no laws discriminate against Canadians by limiting what services they can receive based on their sexual orientation or gender identity
- 2) Allow parents to speak with their own children about sexuality and gender, and set house rules about sex and relationships.
- 3) Allow free and open conversations about sexuality and sexual behaviour
- 4) Not criminalize professional and religious counselling voluntarily requested and consented to by LGBTQ Canadians.
