

I am writing about Bill C 6. I am concerned that Bill C-6 that is going too far and that religious instruction, parental guidance and supportive services for individuals wishing to order their sexual lives in accordance with their religious conscience, faith identity and personal convictions will not be respected. Of course no one should be coerced in regard to sexual orientation and identity, but parental rights, religious beliefs and freedom of speech need to be valued and respected in keeping with the constitution and the charter of human rights.

Please make changes to Bill C-6 so that the bill, clearly exempts religious instruction, parental guidance and the development of religious identity. Reducing sexual attraction or behaviour must also be removed from the definition of 'conversion therapy.'

Without these changes, I believe Bill C-6 is a danger to religious rights and freedom of expression.
