

I am writing here to express concerns of Bill C-6. My ask is to please revise and uphold :

- 1) the fundamental right of parents to make decisions regarding the welfare of their children, specifically their freedom to instruct them in accord with their religious and ethical beliefs.
- 2) the right and freedom of every Christian to voluntarily seek support to live in a manner consistent with their faith identity and beliefs, and in accord with their personal convictions.
- 3) the right and freedom of the Church and other religious communities to counsel and support persons who choose to live their lives and sexuality in accord with moral teachings and the dictates of their conscience
- 4) the right and freedom of the Catholic Church and other religious communities to share their religious and ethical regarding human sexuality

And to

- 5) Allow parents to speak with their own children about sexuality and gender, and set house rules about sex and relationships;
- 6) Not criminalize professional and religious counseling voluntarily requested and consented to by LGBTQ2 Canadians.

Therefore it is extremely important to fix the definition of bill C-6 so to make sure the above items are addressed.
