

Regarding Bill C-6 I would like to see this bill examined further in its definition. Every law proposed should be made and examined scrupulously due to consequences of the individual Canadian afterward. My brief is in regard to parents rights over their own children who they gave birth to, love deeply, raised, and know best. This bill is not clear in regard to fundamental parental rights and I believe will open Pandora's Box in the parenting arena in future.
