I wish to inform the Justice Committee that I am not happy with Bill C-6. This Bill needs to be fixed. As a Canadian Citizen and a parent I firmly believe that the following amendments

need to be addressed:

1. Ban coercive degrading practices that are designed to change a person's sexual or gender identity;
2. Ensure that no laws discriminate against Canadians by limiting what services they can receive based on their sexual orientation or gender;
3. Allow parents to speak to their children about sexuality and gender, and set house rules about sex and relationships;
4. Allow free and open conversations about sexuality and sexual behaviour;  
and
5. Not criminalize professional and religious counseling voluntarily requested and consented to by LGBTQ2 Canadians.

If the Justice Committee continues with Bill C-6 as it is written, I strongly feel that my rights as a Canadian citizen are being eroded.

I trust that the Justice Committee will put every effort into Fixing the Definition.
