

A Brief to
The Standing Committee on
Justice and Human Rights
Concerning Bill C-6(Conversion Therapy)
Dec 7,2020

As Canadian, we want to protect all people from any harm, and it is good intention to protect anyone from being forced to do anything in Canada. **It is too rush to push this Bill.**

This Bill is **one sided, not equal**, while protecting some community but take away others' right which will be against the fundamental Spirit of Canadian Charter Rights and Freedoms. **Lots of terms are not clearly defined and law cannot be made and carried out effectively and fairly.**

1. One sided

This Bill focus merely on causing conversion from LGBTQ to heterosexual, but not causing/helping the change from heterosexual to other sexual orientation/identity, including causing and helping children to change from heterosexual to others without informing the parents.

It is not equal and one sided and will greatly harm the right of parents.

2. Lots of terms is not clearly defined- is it appropriate to introduce a Bill base on lots of undefined terms including:

a) What is the definition of " Forced " and "Caused"

b) In this Bill, it only covers " Conversion Therapy" From LGBTQ to heterosexual, how about the other way round.

c) " Matured Minor" How do you defined "Matured Minor"

d) "Gender identity and orientation" As there is no way to clearing define how each person feel like and personal feeling can change any time, having one sided law will limits the right of each individual to choose what they want. Does that mean once when a person change to LGBTQ, they will loose their right to do other changes in the future(that is a one way system, is this fair?)

3. While parents are pouring out all efforts, hearts , their love and wealth for their children and our Country

is built by many families with parents bringing up and caring for their children. This Bill implies to ignore all parents care by taking away their right for caring for their children and even putting pressure on and scaring them off for taking their children for holidays outside the country.

4.Regarding freedom of Expression (section 2(b)Limiting the ability to advertise for a certain business/services and not the others can be dangerous and unfair. What is the rounding for this limitation?

Please consider the above and not to pass Bill as it is.
