- that C-14 does not allow assisted suicide for those with mental illness, mental and or physical disability and for mature minors.

- that palliative care be made accessible to all and this becomes mandatory in law.
- that there be a third party review, ensured before all proposed deaths.
- that only those with terminal illness be considered and that the term, reasonably foreseeable be properly defined.
- that only doctors will be permitted to assist.
