# Agrilnvest Factsheet

All 2020 transaction year statistics are up to and including June 5, 2020.

Due to a migration of the database and a change in the way the data was collected starting in 2015, we are only able to provide relevant figures for the past 5 years rather than the 10-year history requested by the AGRI Committee.

In Québec the Agrilnvest program is delivered by *La Financière agricole du Québec.* As a result, AAFC does not possess the relevant data for Agrilnvest accounts in that province and numbers provided below do not include accounts in Québec.
