Question 22:

RE: Amendment 4, Answer 20 - C1 and CR2

In response to concerns that as written, CR1 and CR2 put bidders at risk for breaching IP and security contract clauses, the Crown stated: "Canada has reviewed the request, however the requirement remains unchanged. Canada is committed to safeguarding the confidentiality of all bids received in response to this solicitation."

This response does not address the stated issues. Even if the Crown is committed to safeguarding the confidentiality of the bids, *providing* the requested client information will be in breach of vendors' contracts as neither the vendors nor the contractors own this information.

To avoid breaching the IP and security clauses, please remove CR1 and CR2 from this solicitation.

Answer 22:

With respect to CR1, should the Bidder be unable to provide a copy of the Public-Cloud Migration Roadmap example due to concerns regarding Intellectual Property, in order to demonstrate that the Bidder has this experience and to obtain points the Bidder could alternatively provide the following:

Answer 23:

There are 11 resource categories which can be leveraged within the future contract as needs arise, all Level 3 resources. Only those Level 3 resources will be required on an as and when requested basis.

Question 24:

RE: Global FVEY experience

We are concerned about the responses to questions 9 and 10 of solicitation amendment 002 and question 12 of solicitation amendment 003. Given the Crown allows Five Eyes (FVEY) global experience to be used in the project experiences of the resources, would the Crown be willing to accept for the corporate experience references from the FVEY community since the definition of bidder remains unchanged?

Answer 24:

The corporate criteria does not exclude global FVEY (or Border Five) experience. With respect to the definition of the Bidder and its relevance to any of the criteria, project experience described in the criteria must have been performed by the Bidder itself. If the Bidder is a joint venture, please refer to Section 3.1 (i) (i) and (ii) which permits the joint venture to rely on experience of one of its parties unless that experience was performed by a separate joint venture with a third party who is not a participant of this joint venture.
