2024–2025 recruitment campaign

The Honourable Greg Fergus, Speaker of the House of Commons, is pleased to announce the launch of the 2024–2025 recruitment campaign for the House of Commons Page Program.

Each year, 40 bilingual students are selected from across Canada to participate in the Page Program. Pages are students beginning full- or part-time studies at eligible post-secondary institutions in the National Capital Region. They work on a part-time basis during their first year of study and are remunerated under a one-year contract.

Pages carry out a wide range of tasks directly related to Chamber activities, giving them the opportunity to broaden their knowledge of Parliament and play a role in the rich traditions of the Canadian parliamentary system.

Students must submit their applications online **no later than November 8, 2023, at 11:59 p.m.**

Quick facts

- Pages provide high-quality, non-partisan bilingual services to Members of Parliament.
- Pages work under pressure in a fast-paced environment where team spirit and strong time management, communication and interpersonal skills are important.
- Pages' work shifts are tailored to their course schedule to help support the achievement of work-life balance and academic success.
- In addition to their salary, pages are reimbursed for their travel costs at the start and end of their contract.
- The Page Program was introduced in 1978.
